FOR INSTANCE, IN MESOPOTAMIAN MYTHS, THE CONCEPT OF A SACRED GARDEN OR PARADISE EXISTS WITH GODS LIKE ENKI AND ISHTAR PLAYING ROLES IN CREATION AND FERTILITY. SOME SCHOLARS PROPOSE THAT THE BIBLICAL EDEN STORY MIGHT HAVE ABSORBED OR ADAPTED ELEMENTS FROM THESE EARLIER TRADITIONS, HINTING AT A PANTHEON OR GROUP OF DIVINE BEINGS INFLUENCING EDEN'S CREATION AND FUNCTION.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF EDENIC DEITIES IN ANCIENT CULTURES
