Further study however revealed some weaknesses in the dispensationalists' position. While popular dispensationalist books and films did much to focus attention on the subject of the beast and the mark of the beast, these films and books could have been much more accurate if the writers and film producers had followed a more hermeneutical approach to the subject of the beast and the mark of the beast. The book of Daniel uses the symbol of a beast to represent a political power that exercises dominion. The four beasts of Daniel 7 are four great kingdoms namely Babylon, the Medes and the Persians, Greece, and Rome. A fifth power emerges after the collapse of Rome referred to by Daniel as the little horn. A careful analysis of the little horn power of Daniel 7 and the beast of Revelation 13 will reveal that both Daniel and John are describing the same power.
