LIMITATIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

3. **CONTINUOUS EDUCATION:** PAIR HANDBOOK STUDY WITH WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS, AND ONLINE COURSES THAT OFFER HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE.
4. **DOCUMENTATION AND OUTCOME TRACKING:** APPLY THE ASSESSMENT TOOLS AND INTERVENTION STRATEGIES TO MONITOR PATIENT PROGRESS SYSTEMATICALLY.

BY EMBEDDING THE HANDBOOK'S INSIGHTS INTO DAILY ROUTINES, CLINICIANS CAN ELEVATE THE QUALITY OF PEDIATRIC CARE AND SUPPORT BETTER DEVELOPMENTAL OUTCOMES.
